

## Maintenance and cleaning

Thanks to its natural characteristics, it does not stain easily; it is however advisable to clean out the dust regularly with either a soft brush or a vacuum cleaner.

For further cleaning:

### **Not unlinable stuffed furniture**

Spray and rub the cloth surface with dry foam specific for stuffed furniture.

### **Unlinable furniture**


*Washing by hand or machine wash:* use lukewarm water (max 30°C) or set your washing machine on a programme for delicate materials using neutral detergent. Do not squeeze or do not centrifuge. Hang it out on the shadow. If necessary, steam-iron it at the temperature for rayon and synthetic, delicate cloths, with a slightly wet cloth over the leather.

*Dry cleaning:* use only perchloroethylene.

### **Stain removing**

For the removal of stains please follow our "Stain Removal" table. In case you use solvents we don't mention, we suggest you see the fastness colour trying them on a non visible area, of the material:

- 1) act quickly
- 2) start cleaning from outside of the stain towards its centre to avoid halos.
- 3) Identify the kind of stain and act according to our "Stain Removal" table.
- 4) When using a solvent, do not pour it directly onto the fabric, but on a clean white rag.
- 5) Place some weight on it when the cloth is dry.



### “Stain Removal” table

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Drinks, alcohol, spirits, wine	Dry with a clean white rag, shampoo with mild soapy water, then clean with diluted methylated alcohol (10%).
Biro	Clean with 20% methylated alcohol or with perchloroethylene or trichloroethylene.
Coffee, tea, milk	Dry with a clean white rag, then shampoo with mild soapy water.
Chocolate, sweets	Use sponge and warm water (max 40°C)
Paint	<i>Oil colours:</i> clean with turpentine, then shampoo with soapy water. <i>Distemper:</i> shampoo with cold soapy water, if the stain is old ask an expert.
Cosmetics	Shampoo with mild soapy water, in case of persistent stains use 20% methylated spirit, perchloroethylene or trichloroethylene.
Grass, vegetables	Sponge with warm water (max 40°C) then shampoo with mild soapy water.
Ink	Dry with a clean white rag, clean with 20% methylated spirit and shampoo with soapy water.
Shoe polish	Clean with perchloroethylene, trichloroethylene or diluted ammonia (max 10%).
Jam, syrup, fruit juice	Remove most of the dirt with a spoon, then shampoo with warm water (max 40°C).
Oil, grease	Remove with a clean white rag, then clean with trichloroethylene.
Nail varnish	Sponge with nail polish.

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
